Overview and Update on PBL, CCCT, AIC and Center for Data Science.

Brief presentations were made to the Council to update the members on the following academic activities of the University.

- Project Based Learning (PBL) courses, namely (i) 'Calculus for Engineers' and (ii) 'Design and Prototype' for first semester of 2018 batch by Dr. Kavita Chaudhary.
- Courses offered by the Center for Communication & Critical Thinking (CCCT) such as 'The Power of Storytelling', 'Effective Communication Design', 'Personal Communication' and 'Workplace & Interpersonal Communication' by Dr. Richa Mishra.
- Center for Data Science activities by Dr. Alok Kumar
- Atal Incubation Center (AIC) update was shared by Mr. Arihant Jain

Council was happy to know the development and suggested following:

- Students should be motivated to 'Think differently' and 'Think Big'.
- Goal oriented teaching and research to be practiced
- PBL should be implemented in higher semester courses as well.

- While it is good to learn the PBL model from Olin College, JKLU should also aim to contribute its learnings and case studies of PBL experience and share the same with Olin and others.
- IEEE student chapter should be started as soon as possible to be entitled to its various benefits like grants for research projects, conference support, etc. which IEEE offers to its chapters.
- Faculty publications must publish their papers in high impact Journals.
- · AIC should encourage projects on social problems.
- Students must experience more writing engagements. All four components of communication- reading, listening, writing, and speaking should be incorporated in all of their courses in an integrated manner.
- More industry experts should be involved in BOS for program design and delivery. Some experts from Defense and Space sector should also be involved as advisors and collaborators.
- IET faculty should visit IIT Delhi CARE center.
- The IET workshops and laboratories should be given a face-lift.
- 8. Tabling of the Curriculum for B.Tech with tabling of the minutes of the Board of Studies Meeting held on October 13, 2018.

Director IET, Dr. Sanjay Goel presented the Programme Structure for various branches of B.Tech programme. He also tabled the MoM of the Board of Studies meeting held on October 13, 2018. (Annexure-3) Post this, detailed syllabi and evaluation scheme for B.Tech programme (all branches) for upcoming even semesters was presented.

9. Tabling of the Curriculum for Pinnacle MBA and BBA, B.Com Curriculum with tabling of the minutes of the Board of Studies Meeting held on October 06, 2018.

Associate Dean IM, Dr, Manoj Kumar Bhatia, presented the structure of the two-year *Pinnacle MBA* programme and explained the track based classification of courses as: Blended Learning, Management (Core Courses), Management Electives, Workshops.
