Event Name: Session on Developing leadership among the students and make them industry savvy

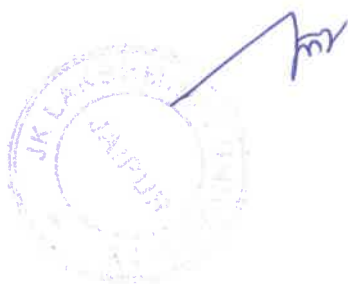

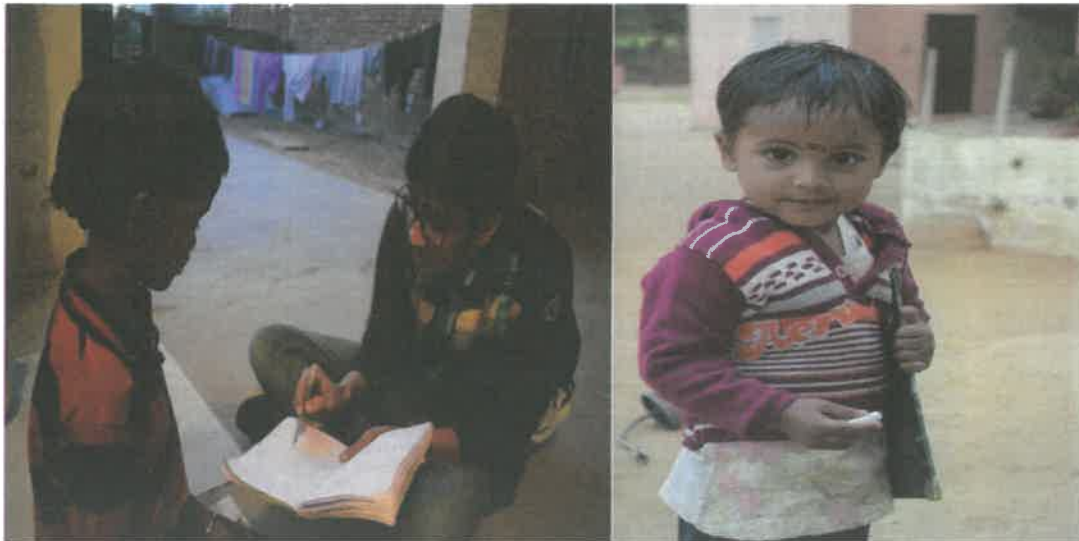

Event Name: Blood donation camp

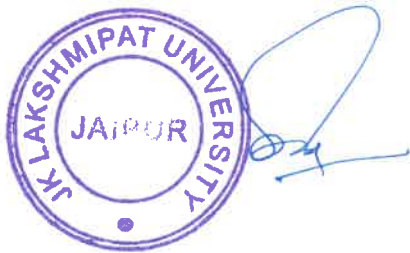
