The workshop focused on the existing electric/hybrid vehicle technology but also allows the participants to know the future market and technology trends.


The following key points were covered in the workshop:

- Battery Management systems



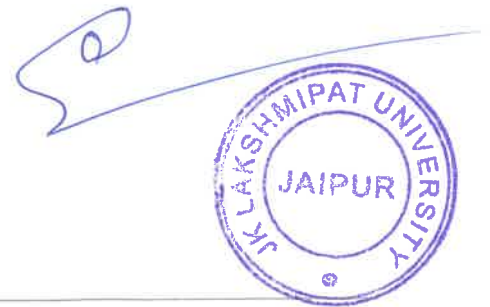
The hands on exercise equipped investors to restructure their portfolios and achieve goals with independence.
