Report on Open Day (March 16, 2019)

JKLU organized its third Open Day on March 16, 2019 (Saturday). The aim of this event was to have a dialogue with parents who are the partners of University in the progress and development of their wards studying in JKLU and to share with them the outcomes achieved so far.

The day started with two technical competitions. Department of Mechanical Engineering organized a technical competition, 'TechBout 2019' that included 'Rachna' an AutoCAD Design Challenge and 'Grip-a-bot' a Gripper Bot Competition. This competition was coordinated by Mrs. Deepika Mishra. The second competition was the onsite final of "AlgoRythm_19.1" an ACM-ICPC style inter-college competitive programming contest was organized by Competitive Programming Club in association with Computer Society of India, Jaipur (CSI-JKLU Student Chapter). The preliminary round of this contest was organized on March 9, 2019 in which Total 47 teams comprises of 126 programmers from different reputed colleges/universities BIT-Mesra, IIIT-Allahabad, IIIT-Noida, JKLU-Jaipur, MAIT-New Delhi, NIT-Kurukshetra, NSUT-New Delhi, and USICT-GGSIPU-New Delhi participated. This competition was coordinated by Mr. Santosh Verma. On this occasion, Department of Mechanical Engineering launched its first e-Vehicle that the team of its students developed in JKLU campus under faculty supervision. In addition to all these activities, a project exhibition was also organized in which students of various programs demonstrated their projects related to Physics, IoT, Automation, Mechanical, Software Engineering, Cyber Security, etc. This exhibition also included few projects as outcome of PBL courses.

As a key activity of Open Day, parents interacted with the faculty members and discussed the progress of their wards. This session continued for more than 2 hours. The faculty members discussed the challenges faced by students, and efforts required from parents in motivating students to achieve success.

This interaction was followed by an Open House session between University officials and parents. The aim was to convey these initiatives that the University has taken to make its students, not just 'Job ready' but 'Life ready'. Open House started with a welcome address by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the University, Dr. Roshan Lal Raina. Dr. Raina thanked all the parents for coming and shared the importance of Open Day. He also shared the highlights of few important events that were taken place at JKLU including JKLU Laureate Award. Thereafter, Director-IET Dr. Sanjay Goel interacted with parents and by sharing some key initiative taken by University, he urged all the audience to aim high. Student Council was also introduced with the parents on this occasion. Cultural representative, Mr. Nikhil Jhanwar shared his experience of being in Student Council. A short video on the JKLU's Journey of past one year was also presented by the council. All the officers, staff members and faculty members were present during this Open House session. This was a very good opportunity for all the parents to meet them all together. The parents also shared their experience and feedback during this Open House session.
