He requested them to review the curriculum keeping in view the current trends in the industry and society. He mentioned that the management education is a multidisciplinary programme which needs constant updations. The University looks upon the experts from Industry and academia for their guidance and support towards this activity. He further mentioned that Institute of Management goal is to develop foresight, skills and provide practical dimension to our all course curriculum.

Dr. S.K. Majumdar also welcomed the members of BoS and shared his vision and goal of taking Institute of Management, JKLU forward. He emphasized his focus on academic rigor and development of students who not only would be excellent managers but also leading entrepreneurs in coming times. He informed that after five batches of IM from 2011 to 2015; from the sixth batch of 2016 onwards, the Coding Scheme of Courses has been revised which was put up for the approval of BoS. Further, several updations / modifications / additions have been done in the curriculum which would bring the Syllabuses in tune with the current times. He endeared the members to provide their valuable suggestions which could be then incorporated in the curriculum design.

Minutes of previous meeting were approved by the members.

The draft syllabi of MBA (FT) Batch 2016-18; BBA+MBA (Dual Degree) Batch 2016-21 and B.Com.(Hons)+MBA(Dual Degree) Batch 2016-21 prepared by the Faculty Council were tabled for discussion by the members of the Boards of Studies.

- g. The title of the subject 'Managing Human Resources' in Semester II is changed as HR02 Human Resources Management.
- h. **OM02** Logistics and Supply Chain Management which was a core course earlier in Semester III is shifted to Operations Management Electives for the same Semester.
- i. In view of the focus on Digital India and the ever increasing role of IT in business and Industry, a new subject *IT03 E-Business* is introduced as a core subject in the Semester III.
- j. The HR Elective subject *HR09 Human Resources Planning* is replaced by 'Human Resource Analytics'.
- k. The title for course code LS05 Soft Skill-I should be replaced as 'Basic Communication Skills'.
- 1. The title for course code *LS06 Soft Skill-II* should be replaced as 'Oral Communication Skills'.
- m. The title for course code LS07 'Soft Skill-III should be replaced as 'Written Communication Skills'.
- n. The title for course code LS08 Soft Skill-IV should be replaced as 'Business Etiquettes'.
- o. It was suggested to update the IT01 Information Technology for Managers subject.
- p. It was suggested to add IT Components to MK06 Retail Management and OM02 Logistics and Supply Chain Management subjects.
- q. It was suggested to include Big Data in *IT04 Relational Database Management System* and Cases in *IT08 Business Analytics*.
- r. It was suggested to include Agile Management in OM03 Project Management.
- s. The title for course code *HR06 Performance Management* should be replaced as 'Performance and Talent Management'.
- t. The title for course code *IB02 Export Management and Documentation* should be replaced as 'International Trade and Documentation'.
- 3. The suggestion of the members for making the course syllabi more practice oriented was incorporated in the curriculum and Industry experts for the specific subjects should be engaged for at least 4 to 6 sessions in a semester to give more practical inputs.

BBA + MBA (5 Years) Dual Degree Programme

- 1. The members of the BOS expressed satisfaction and commented that the course has been designed comprehensively.
- 2. The members of the BOS suggested the following changes which were incorporated:
 - a. The title for course code *LS02 Developing Language Skills* should be replaced as 'English Language Skills'.
 - b. The title for course code QT04 Introduction to Statistics should be replaced as 'Fundamentals of Statistics'.
 - c. The title for course code *QT09 Basic Mathematics* should be replaced with 'Fundamentals of Mathematics'.
 - d. The title for course code GN14 Introduction to Micro Economics should be replaced as 'Micro Economics'.
 - e. The title for course code GN15 Introduction to Macro Economics should be replaced as 'Macro Economics'.
 - f. The title of the subject 'Human Resources Management' in Semester III is changed as *HR11* Managing Human Resources.
 - g. The title for course code *AC07 Income tax law and practice* should be replaced as 'Direct tax Laws and Practice'.
 - h. The title for course code *MK08 Principle of Marketing-I* should be replaced as 'Marketing Process and Elements'.
 - i. The title for course code *MK09 Principle of Marketing-II* should be replaced as 'Advertising and Sales Management'.
 - j. The title for course code GN16 Introduction to Indian Economy should be replaced as 'Indian Economy'.
 - k. The title for course code LS05 Soft Skill-I should be replaced as 'Basic Communication Skills'.
 - 1. The title for course code LS06 Soft Skill-II should be replaced as 'Oral Communication Skills'.
 - m. The title for course code LS07 'Soft Skill-III should be replaced as 'Written Communication Skills'.
 - n. The title for course code LS08 Soft Skill-IV should be replaced as 'Business Etiquettes'.

- u. Make addition of Chapter on "NPA Management, Stressed Assets, Asset Reconstruction, Corporate Debt Restructuring, Sarfaesi Act and Functions of Banking Ombudsman" in course code *FN10 Indian Banking System*.
