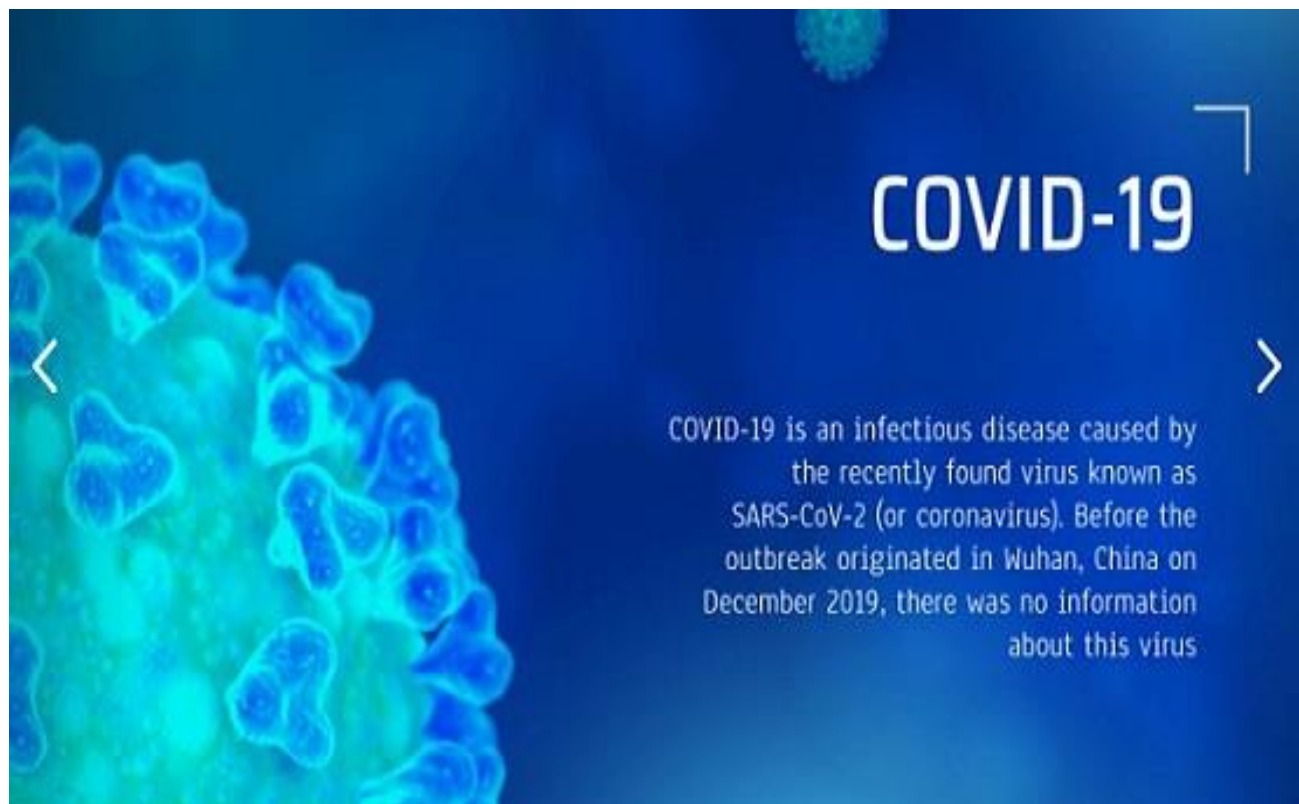

Panel discussion on 'Personal, Professional and Spiritual Life post Covid'

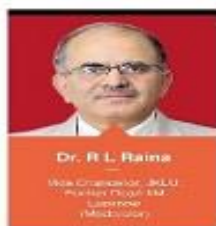


